

# POST STREET CLOSURE AND DETOUR

## Van Ness Campus Hospital Project

**Thursday, July 27, 2017 through Monday, July 31, 2017**

Construction of the new Sutter Health CPMC Van Ness Campus Hospital continues to progress on schedule. The HerreroBOLDT team is preparing to take down the project's final tower crane, marking the achievement of another major milestone in the construction work.

To facilitate the removal of the tower crane, **Post Street between Van Ness Avenue and Franklin Street will be closed beginning on Thursday, July 27, 2017 at 12:01 a.m. and will reopen on Monday, July 31, 2017 at 6:00 a.m.** To ensure the safety of everyone, there will be no pedestrian or vehicular access through the closure area. The Post Street detour will have no impact on Van Ness Avenue.

Alternative routes will be clearly marked during the detour and HerreroBOLDT is working collaboratively with the city's transit agencies to minimize the impact on public transportation.
